In a continuous effort to be green, we have saved the paper and created an online goodie bag for you to select which coupons you'd like to use. We will email you on November 1 with a link to your goodie bag and a reminder to look for your bib in the mail.

Getting to the Race

We have heard your requests and with a slightly modified race course, we are able to keep Highway 87 at Julian open in both directions during the race. If traveling south on 87, please exit Julian and turn right towards the HP Pavilion and park in the lot in the back of the arena. You can also exit from the back, turning westbound on Julian to the Alameda. If traveling north on Highway 87, exit on to northbound 280 and exit at Bird, turning right, you will arrive at multiple flat lots near the arena.

Special Hybrid Vehicle parking is available in the lot on the corner of Autumn and Santa Clara: 150 spaces of front row parking is dedicated just for hybrid vehicles. Take 280, exit on Bird Ave traveling north towards arena. After passing San Fernando, the entrance to the lot will be on your left hand side before Santa Clara Street.

Public Transportation: The use of public transportation to get to the 7th Annual Applied Materials "Silicon Valley Turkey Trot" is encouraged. For bus and light rail information visit: VTA.org.
